
View iPad photos all together in Photos for Mac

If you've synced your iPad to your Mac and you want to see all of your iPad photos separate from your other ones, here's one way to do that with a smart album


Open Photos on your Mac



Go to the view menu and select "show sidebar" - this will make it easier to find groups of photos




Go to the file menu and select "new smart album"




A smart album will search your photos library for a specific type of photo

Give your album a name

From these menus, select "camera model" from the first one, then click on the last one and find the type of iPad you have (LHN uses iPad Air)



You'll see your smart album here



Note: Your iPad photos will still show up in other places, such as all photos, faces, and other albums that match the criteria for those photos. This is just one way to show those photos all in one place.
